

Transform Your Chord Progressions With This Easy Trick

Lesson Summary



This summary sheet is a guide on how to take a chord progression and 'mess around' with it. This is great for things such as adding texture in a band setting, accompanying a singer or just playing solo.

1

Learn & familiarize yourself with every inversion of each chord.

You can also practice breaking the chords up by not playing all of the notes at the same time.

Get a metronome on and practice playing around with different inversions using rhythmic variations.

2

Learn and familiarize yourself with the minor blues scale (*the scale must be in the same key as the chord progression*).

Practice playing through the progression whilst occasionally using a couple of notes from the blue scale to help link the chords together.

You can also add some embellishments using notes from the blues scale to spice things up, but make sure you don't overdo this!
